

## Finally a name for playground

The playground on the Columbusstraat was built around 1967, according to a local resident. All these years, the playground has not had a name. The Kerkakkers Kidz Club wanted to change that. The other two playgrounds in our neighborhood have already been named by local residents. The playground on the Dr. Schaepmanstraat is called "t Schaepke" and the playground on the Minister Aalbersestraat is called "t Mollenveldje", named after the former manager.

The Kerkakkers Kidz Club held a competition for all children in the neighbourhood and all children from primary school De Pionier. On Wednesday afternoon, May 29, the children came to the playground with parents right after schoolen with their parents or grandparents for the award ceremony.

Our district alderman Mieke Theus presented the prizes and unveiled the nameplate together with the prize winner. The playground now bears the name: "t Pionierke".



The winner is Michiel Smets, 9 years old. He also knew how to substantiate why he chose this name. He says, it's next to De Pionier primary school, so that fits well. And in a playground, it is always pioneering for a child. Inventing new ways to use the playground. So it's doubly fitting! Also not to forget that the playground is located between streets named after famous pioneers.

The second prize went to: Joshue Zijlmans, 8 years old. He came up with the name: "d'n Grote Boom". The third prize went to the twins Janice and Ivy Stekhuizen, 7 years old. They came up with the name: "Kerk Rakkertjes".

During the ceremony it was just a bit dry, it was a nice meeting between about 60 local residents and participants, a success for our neighborhood! There were also journalists from the Valkenswaards

### Caregiver in Valkenswaard?



Valkenswaard has more than 1.100 informal caregivers. People who care for a loved one. Support Verlicht is there to

support informal caregivers in Valkenswaard. The support centre is part of the GGD Brabant Zuidoost and has a lot of experience in informing and supporting informal caregivers.

As a caregiver, you have a lot to deal with and that can raise a lot of questions. How should this be done? Where can I go for help? What's next? Can I handle all this? For all these and similar questions, please contact Steunpunt Mantelzorg Verlicht Valkenswaard.

You can easily ask questions by phone, but it is also possible to make an appointment with a caregiver at your home. What exactly is caregiving? It is care that you give to someone close to you for a long time and/or intensively. Especially for housemates, informal care is more than the care you usually give to each other. Informal care is often referred to as providing care to a loved one for at least 8 hours a week, voluntarily and unpaid, for at least 3 consecutive months.

#### Information and advice:

It is important to find a balance between caring for someone else and your own wishes and needs. Talking about it can help. This can be done individually or in groups. For individual support, please contact:

- National informal care line, tel. 0900-2020 496 **Emotional support:**

Good support for informal caregivers helps to balance their burden and capacity. Sometimes, as a caregiver, you need a little extra support. This can be done through individual conversations, but also through training and courses. For an individual consultation, you can make an appointment with an informal care consultant from the Steunpunt Mantelzorg Verlicht.

There are also several group meetings that focus on caregivers.

#### **Practical support:**

Sometimes it is nice and sometimes it is necessary that there are 'extra' hands to share care. If you're used to caring for someone close to you, it can be a big step to seek outside help. Nevertheless, it can be useful to make use of practical support options. This help is often aimed at the care recipient, but it can also ease the tasks of the informal caregiver. Some help is provided by volunteers, others by paid professionals:

- Household help
- Help with care and nursing
- Transport
- Assistive devices
- Domotica
- Meal provision
- Helping hands

The municipality is responsible for a number of tasks through the Wet Maatschappelijke Ondersteuning (Wmo). This includes household assistance, living facilities, transport facilities and means of transport. If you have any support questions, please contact the Sociaal team of the Gemeente Valkenswaard.
