Yet their numbers have halved since the 1970s.

Hands-on tips for the birds in your garden

Make cupcakes for birds:

1. Get creative with bird food and treat birds to some treats: cheerful bird cupcakes to make yourself.

2. Slowly melt some hard frying oil in a pan.
3. The heat can be turned off before all the fat has melted. It takes quite a long time for the fat to solidify again.
4. Add a lot of seeds to the liquid fat. Now it's just a matter of waiting for the fat to cool down slightly.
5. Then pour it into the desired molds.

Good turnout and lots of 'green' ideas at biodiversity workshop

On 13 March, the theme of the 'For & Door' meeting was biodiversity in the neighbourhood. With a good turnout and even better 'green' results, we can speak of a successful workshop and a pleasant evening. About twenty local residents visited the evening. Three people from the IVN Valkenswaard-Waalre were also present. This was a welcome addition. They were able to share their knowledge and experience in the field of greening and biodiversity projects with us. The workshop started with an overview of the municipal 'actions/projects and subsidy opportunities; Subsidies for disconnecting rainwater or for green (sedum) roofs, for example. Municipal green projects that have been carried out in recent years or are still ongoing: adoption of a tree mirror, façade gardens, tile flipping, tiny pools and the free boxes. Afterwards, the local residents were inspired by a presentation of 'green' actions that take place elsewhere in our country and abroad.

Results workshop

We split up into groups to brainstorm about green projects for our neighborhood, and with results! A total of twenty ideas were written down.

- 1) At number one was 'Expedition 10' by Early Birds. A new initiative to introduce as many children as possible to ten animals and plants in their own environment. Can you name 10 plant species and 10 animal species? That's why the idea was born to turn it into a neighborhood safari walk for all local residents.
- 2) A shared second place for the theme "more flowery grasslands/(median) verges" was shared with the theme "green walls and green façade cladding". You can think of ivy, honeysuckle, and wisteria against the wall for example.
- 3) Thirdly, there is the wish to organize a plant, cutting, and/or seed exchange day (again). A fun social activity where local residents can also meet each other.

What's next??

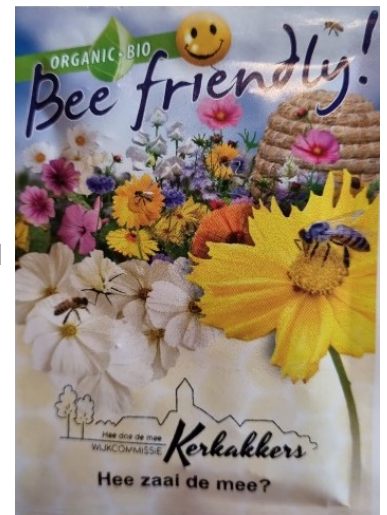
Within the biodiversity working group, we discuss all twenty results and investigate how and when we can get started with some of the activities. This will depend on capacity, time and financial resources. We can pick up various ideas with the municipality, other ideas with other working groups from the neighborhood and we can look at other partners such as the IVN, Lunet and primary school De Pionier.
